WELCOME TO SHINE MINISTRY

Shine Ministry seeks to equip and disciple children, students, and adults with disabilities and their families into the life and community of Southeast Christian Church. We believe God has given each of us unique abilities and talents for his glory and our good. As a ministry team, we strive to empower individuals with disabilities to know and love Jesus Christ and others with their unique abilities. We provide age and developmentally appropriate ways for individuals with disabilities to hear the Gospel of Jesus while also building connection and community at Southeast Christian Church.

We currently offer specialized weekly worship programming at five campuses -- Blankenbaker, Bullitt County, Crestwood, Indiana and Southwest. A complete list of our weekend worship classes are listed in the column on the left side of this page.

LEARNING MORE ABOUT SHINE MINISTRY

• How are Shine Kids classes structured? What is the age range of the students?

Our Shine Kids classes are for children ages 3-12 who benefit from an adapted class with additional space for movement. The classes feature worship time with a Bible lesson, crafts, and free play. Our Shine rooms include sensory spaces and play zones with different activities. All Shine Kids classes are led by trained volunteers who disciple students with love and care that helps them know more about Jesus.

• What can I expect in the Shine Adults/Teens classes? What is the age range of those students?

Our Shine Adults/Teens classes are for adults of all ages as well as teens who prefer smaller groups and a sensory-friendly setting. The classes include worship, crafts, and a Bible lesson. Shine rooms feature classroom seating, soft seating, and sensory spaces allowing for an adapted space accommodating many needs. Our Shine classes are led by trained volunteers who disciple students with love and care that helps them to know more about Jesus.

• How does check-in, check-out work for Shine classes?

Check-in kiosks are located near the entrance to our Shine rooms at all of our campuses. All students are checked-in at one of our kiosks and each of them receive a check-in label to enter our worship spaces. Parents, guardians or caregivers accompanying our students will receive a unique code for check-out after worship. All students should be checked out immediately following the completion of the worship service.

• What about students who attend SE!Kids, MSM or HSM but need a little extra help?

In addition to our weekly worship classes inside our Shine spaces, we also partner with our children's ministry, middle school ministry and high school ministry teams to provide trained oneon-one classroom friends for those students who need additional support in those settings.

JOIN US IN THE SHINE CAFE AT BLANKENBAKER

Since its launch in November 2021, the Shine Cafe at the Blankenbaker Campus has provided a unique space for Christ-centered community and fellowship. Located just inside the main entrance at the Blankenbaker Campus, the Shine Cafe glorifies God by equipping and empowering adults with disabilities as baristas where they receive job training, life skills and one-on-one discipleship as they serve others. At Shine Ministry, we believe God has given each of us exceptional abilities and talents for his glory and the Shine Cafe serves as a catalyst for our baristas to celebrate God's perfect design.

Starting August 7, the Shine Cafe will be open five days per week -- Sundays from 8 am to 1 pm; Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesday from 8:30 am to 3 pm; and Thursdays from 5:30 pm to 7 pm.

SHINE SUITE | BLANKENBAKER CAMPUS

Launched in August 2020, the Shine Ministry Suite at the Blankenbaker Campus provides 5,000-square feet of ministry space where we offer weekly worship classes for kids, teens and adults. Below are answers to some frequently asked questions about our Shine Ministry Suite.

• When is the Shine Suite open during weekend services?

We offer worship classes inside the Shine Suite at the Blankenbaker Campus during the 6:30 pm service on Thursdays and both the 9 am and 11:15 am services on Sundays. Check-in for the Thursday 6:30 pm service is open from 6 pm until 6:50 pm. Check-in for the Sunday 9 am service is open from 8:30 am until 9:20 am. Check-in for the Sunday 11:15 service is open from 10:45 am until 11:35 am.



• Where should we park and enter at the Blankenbaker Campus?

We suggest entering the building at Door 10, which is under the Shine Ministry signage on the outside windows of the Shine Suite. There is ample parking in Lot D near Entrance 2 on Watterson Trail, which is a short walk to Door 10.

• Where is the Shine Suite located inside the church?

The entrance to the Shine Suite is accessible from the 2nd floor of the Atrium between the Media Center and the living room classrooms. If you enter the building from Door 10, use the elevator just inside the Atrium and the Shine Suite is on the 2nd floor.



• How does check-in, check-out work in the Shine Suite?

Check-in kiosks are located inside the Shine Suite. All students will be checked-in at one of our kiosks and each of them will receive

a check-in label to enter our worship spaces. Parents, guardians or caregivers accompanying our students will receive a unique code for check-out after worship. All students should be checked out immediately following the completion of the worship service.
